- We had an addition of two new classrooms in the sanctuary. This provided much needed room for our expanding ministry. The 2 & 3 yr olds now have a permanent room located across from the nursery. Also, the 1st – 5th grade children have joined us in the sanctuary providing a central location for families with newborns to 5th grade.
- We made nursery improvements including remodeling for better effectiveness and installed a bathroom for improved security.
- We improved our check in/out system with new ID cards for families to provide enhanced security and faster service.
- We have introduced two helpful media sources for parents; Parent Link News Letter & Trû Home-front monthly.
- In September 2009 we became a Beta test church for Trû curriculum for ages 2 through 5th grade.
 - Trû is a dynamic, spiritually forming, and family-empowered curriculum that offers kids a vibrant Sunday lesson, as well as parent resources that meet the specific needs of today's lifestyle.
 - Trû is uniquely developed to inspire "Teachers", equip "Kids", and support "Parents".
 - The Trû team strongly believes that spiritual development can and should begin from the earliest age with parents as the primary nurturers of their children's faith.

"KIDMO" has games, prizes, team competitions, small groups, memory verses, and praise and worship music videos that are exciting and brings the scriptures of the Bible alive and relevant to children.

- 2009 annual Conferences included *Prophetic Advance* with Chuck Pierce, Stacy Campbell and Rachel Hickson. Chuck Pierce released that 2009 would be the year that the River of God would be released from the womb and so was made evident by the scores of new births in that year at ICLV. Stacey Campbell taught us how to pray the scriptures and released personal prophetic words over ICLV's leadership. Rachel Hickson was as spiritually charged as ever and even released spontaneous new words to Michael Leyde's song Let God Arise from the platform! Of course the word of the Lord was spoken and heard setting the course for 2009 for ICLV and its congregants.
- 2009 annual Conferences also included *Holy Spirit Conference* with Heidi Baker, Bishop Garlington and Bill Johnson and worship guests Brian and Ramey Whalen. It was our highest attended conference to date.
 - The registration site www.HolySpiritConference.com provided this year's guests the opportunity to register, and have a detailed list of nearby accommodations, personal biographies on each of our guest speakers

and worship guests, as well as a general conference schedule including available workshops.

- Additional 'internet' exposure for HSC 2009 included an event posting on Elijah List's as well as, internet email blasts and advertisements by way of XP Media. HSC was also featured for the first time in Charisma magazine with a ½ page ad and ran in conjunction with a featured article on ICLV. Hundreds of clicks were tracked visiting both the registration site and through www.iclv.com which proved advertising expenses not only promoted the conference, but ICLV at large.
- Beyond our general conference sessions this year's workshops featured two separate sessions of classes taught by ICLV covenant pastors and staff members. It provided attendees both training and relational opportunities. All workshops this year were overflowing due to a strategic change of scheduling them after the morning sessions instead of before.
- Mission's hosted a barbeque fundraiser after Tuesday and Wednesday morning sessions raising thousands of dollars for ICLV missions.

KAIROS SCHOOL OF MINISTRY

PURPOSE: To Know the Love God and to share this Love with others with an expectation of God's presence, His power and His passion. Kairos is a school to train and mobilize leaders who will bring revival and reformation in the arena of world missions, urban missions, internet missions and intercession.

UPDATE

Kairos Day and Night School of Ministry 2009/2010 School Year:

- We currently have 24 day students and 35 students in our Fast Track program.
- Our day students consist of both first and second year students ages 18 and up.
- Kairos students are participating in classes such as Kingdom Foundations, Old Testament Studies, New Testament studies, Breakthrough, Doctrine, Prophetic, Culture of Honor, Communication, Social Reformation, History of Revival and

Revivalists, Social Roles and Relationships, The Life of Christ, Missions, Acts and Paul's Epistles, World Missions, Intercession and many other exciting subjects. They also have accountability groups, internships, prayer and community outreaches.

- Students are also being trained in the arts such as worship, drama, dance and painting.
- We have testimonies every week of all that God is doing in the lives of our students and in the way that He is using them around our city.
- Kairos is leading 7am prayer twice a week and is a “burning force” of the intercession movement in the city.
- Kairos Fast Track is a two year program with classes and electives offered throughout the year. Subjects of study are consistent with what is taught in the day time program.
- Fast Track students are getting more involved as leaders at ICLV and are being trained to be healthy whole individuals who release the kingdom of God wherever they go.

Kairos internships & community outreaches

- Kairos students from both day and night school are being released for hands on training and impartation in all of aspects of ICLV church ministry such as: Men's, Woman's, Youth, Royal Rangers, Missionettes, Multimedia, HomeGrown Young Adult ministry, altar care, as well as helping the other campus ministries at the South Gate and the Dream Center.
- Outreaches are consistent each week as we are bringing revival through prophetic evangelism and intercession in places on the strip, Fremont Street Experience, local neighborhood, local malls, parks and hospitals. We have done silent sieges for life, praying for the ending of abortions in our state and nation. Students are participating in out of state revival meetings in places such as Arizona, Utah, Hollywood, San Diego, North Carolina and other local churches in our city and state.
- Students are also involved in social reformation bringing awareness and solutions to the problem of Human Trafficking, homeless youth in our local schools, and foster care issues encouraging the local church body to consider foster care of children in our city and state.

Current Events

- In September of 2009 I was transitioned as the new Director of the Kairos School of ministry.
- Dr. Richard Durfield has come on board as our Academic Dean and is in process of helping to bring partnership with accredited colleges with the goal being that Kairos class units will be transferable to Christian colleges and universities.
- Kairos School of ministry will have a focus of 12 core courses that President Paul Goulet has considered to be the DNA of ICLV and of what God has imparted in his life and ministry. These core courses will be the foundation for starting other Kairos schools of ministry around the world.

- Kairos Ottawa in Canada will be our first extension school of ministry that will start up in September 2010.
 - We have launched our Kairos website www.KairosExperience.com.
 - We are also excited to partner with the new school of the arts called S.P.A.R.K in September of 2010.

Men’s ministries continued to bring the fellowship of the Father to the men of ICLV through small groups known as tribes. MISSIONS MINISTRY

ICLV continues to take the gospel around the world under the apostolic vision of Pastor Goulet. Your giving enabled Pastor Paul Goulet to minister with an apostolic and leadership vision in such countries as Canada, France, India, Indonesia, Singapore, and Switzerland. We continued to support orphanages in India, Mexico, and Kenya, in addition to slum schools outside of Delhi, India. - We've had significant and sustained growth.
- We began the 2009 year with 220 attendees and ended the 2009 year with 320 attendees.
- We've added a second Sunday service which is bi-lingual.
- We've implemented an evangelistic – 3 tier system
 - Personal evangelism (*Door to Door*)

- Prophetic evangelism (*Shopping Centers, Skate Parks, etc.*)
- Corporate evangelism (*Campus Outreaches*)
- Outreaches; Easter, Christmas, Harvest Fest, Back-to-School Back Pack Giveaway, VBS, and product give-a-ways.
- We had Four Christmas plays with over 1050 people in attendance. There were 99 salvations plus one baby that was to be boarded saved.

- We finished the week with a Back-to-School backpack give-away where over 400 people were in attendance and 100 salvations.
- Our Adult Sunday School “Road Map to Destiny” is doing GREAT and we implemented our prophetic classes this year.
- We launched our wonderful worship leaders Sergio and Katia Ocanas to the Hispanic ministry to Summerlin Campus in February and Brett & Sherry Colvin to do a work in Utah in October.
- Men’s ministry is going strong; we are still having bi-monthly events; breakfast, bowling, etc.
- Our Knight’s program, which is our “Men of Valor” leadership program continue to meet weekly for devotionals and to clean and meet any needs for South Gate Campus.
- Women’s ministry continues to meet with different events such as Mother’s Day tea, Women’s conferences and Ladies night out!
- We launched Gary & a team who feed the homeless on Wednesday’s and we have added Thursday’s also to feed them with a hot meal and provide any sundries they may need. We have seen 28 of our homeless friends restored to mainstream society and now have jobs and places to live.
- We sponsored 20 families for Christmas with gifts for the whole family and Christmas dinner.
- We partnered with the Dream Center for “Operation Christmas Blessing” and were able to give over 400 Christmas gifts to needy children at South Gate and our adopt a blocks.
- We adopted two more neighborhoods which we bring food, product and the Word regularly.

We are also helping to promote relationship building through monthly activities. There are special events scheduled each month outside of the ministry dynamic which usually involves a fun activity around the city. We will be sowing into the city with “acts of kindness” by actively participating in Dream Center outreaches, and ministering to homeless high school students.
 - Studio 678 – Middle School Ministry – The goal for middle school ministries for 2010 is to completely break away from high school ministry. Presently, middle school meets as a separate ministry on Sundays at 9:00 A.M. in the chapel; however, they meet with the high school students on Wednesday’s as they attend their program. By the end of the year Middle School students will meet as its own ministry with youth events, camps and conferences autonomous from High School ministry.
 - Jesus Culture – National Youth Event – April 9-10 This will be held at ICLV attracting hundreds if not thousands of students from all across the country.
 - Summer Jam – Disneyland /Beach trip – June 14-19 Combined High school and Middle school trip. Intended for ICLV and sister campus students to create unity among the students, spiritual development, and fun.

WELLNESS CENTER

The vision of the Wellness Center is to coordinate all aspects of our spiritual, emotional and physical health. The center is booming and we are excited to provide healing to our congregation and the community. We have began a system of training our staff and leaders on how to become more “well” themselves and equipping them with more knowledge about mental health and how to better facilitate health in marriage, families and individuals in the church.

The Wellness Center officially started in the summer of 2008. In Jan 2009, we have grown from one marriage and family therapist student and one MFT supervisor, to

six MFT interns, and two MFT students, providing individual, family and group counseling.

- Therefore, we also provide services that address areas of physical health, which currently includes a Sunday school class on nutrition, and personal consulting is available as well. In the future we plan to expand in the physical aspect of health. Currently, we also have a team that provides deliverance, inner healing, and pastoral care.
 - The counseling fees range from \$25-150 per session, with scholarships available on a need basis. A link to the Wellness Center has been added to ICLV.com so that people can access information about our services that we provide.
 - Pastor Elaine is the Pastor of Wellness who will be facilitating an inner healing seminar this year and starting a life coaching certification program to help serve the Dream Center and the South Gate in the mental health arena.
 - We are also working to have a Wellness Seminar at the church on a yearly basis as well.
 - The structure of groups will probably change this year to include more lay support groups.
